

ANCIENT CITY GAME FISH ASSOCIATION (ACGFA) 2025 JUNIOR CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT RULES

CHALLENGE DIVISIONS AND RULES:

- 1. Anglers compete for the largest kingfish in the kingfish division.
- 2. Junior Angler fishing day is FRIDAY June 27th.
- **3**. All General Kingfish Challenge rules apply except as noted here: In the spirit of competition, it is the intent of the tournament to have the junior angler strike and fight the fish to the boat. However, since safety and a fun experience are of paramount concern, adult assistance is not considered a violation of tournament rules if personal safety, damage, or loss of equipment is a concern.

AGE REQUIREMENT:

Young Angler: Angler must be fifteen (15) years or younger. Angler must not be older than 15 years old as of the day of tournament.

REGISTRATION:

Registration fee is \$25 per junior angler. Registration can be done by mail, online at www.acgfachallenge.com or at the Captains Meeting from 5:00 to 7:00 PM on June 26th.

WEIGH-IN:

Junior anglers must present their fish at official weigh-in. Weigh-in is from 3:00 – 5:00 PM on Friday. All anglers must be in line at the weigh station at the Camachee Cove Yacht Harbor at the close of weigh-in for their fish to count.

CHECK-OUT AND CHECK-IN:

There is NO visual check out all anglers MUST wait till safe light to fish. No boats may leave the inlet prior to safe light. The tournament VHF radio channel is Channel 72.

PRIZES:

Prizes are limited to ONE per angler. Awards will be presented 2 hours after general weigh in on Saturday June 28th. Anglers MUST be present to collect prizes, at awards ceremony on Saturday.
